


# Set Preferences for Analysis, Edition for OLAP

## Procedure

1. Press any key or click anywhere to continue




The Preferences option in SAP BusinessObjects Analytics, edition for OLAP determine what data connection to use, and the Accessibility Mode.

### 2. Click **Preferences**.










4. Select the **Accessibility Mode** check box.






6. Click **OK**.






