### Items for Discussion

<b>1</b>	<b>GSA Vehicles</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Penny provided a presentation on GSA Vehicles. MARS is pulling in GSA Vehicle information along with NOAA accounting information and stored accounting. Her presentation provided screen shots of the reports within the system. The team is still trying to figure out the inventory piece of it.</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<b>Labor Reports Demo</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sylvia Scott provided a demo of the Labor Reports she has created. The goal was to see if the reports should be promoted to NOAA production and if they are something other LO's would find useful. LO's need more time to understand the reports.</li> </ul>
<b>3</b>	<b>Flux Reporting</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This is a follow up to the last MARS Council. Maureen is still trying to schedule a meeting with Jon Alexander to discuss this.</li> </ul>
<b>4</b>	<b>CBuy/CRequest Update</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Per the last Council, NIST is using BO and has a universe and several reports, which they have shared with us. Reports that we obtained from NIST are now working in pre-prod. We are in the process of setting up accounts for folks to see these reports. We still need to figure out what reports we can use/modify and what is missing; will continue to update the Council on the status at future Council Meetings.</li> </ul>

5	<p>Upgrade to Business Objects 3.1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The MARS Business Objects Team is in the process of upgrading the software to version 3.1. The schedule is as follows:</li> </ul> <p>NOV 2 - NOV 5: Prep for migration  NOV 9 - NOV 13: Prep for migration  NOV 16 - NOV 20: Migrate DEV  NOV 23 - NOV 27: Migrate PREPROD  NOV 30 - DEC 4: Migrate PREPROD  DEC 7 - DEC 11: Migrate PROD  DEC 14 - DEC 18: Migrate PROD</p> <p>Some notable new features in 3.1 include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Updated support for required server side and user side components (Web Application server and browser versions, e.g., support for IE 8.0)</li> <li>2) Optional prompts - reports prompts that can optionally be used by the report user</li> <li>3) Data tracking - highlights changed values on reports</li> <li>4) Numerous usability and performance enhancements</li> <li>5) Improved Query - HTML viewer. Query - HTML viewer is an optional view mode that uses only HTML instead of Java. This mode is an alternative when Java versions become a problem. In the current version, however, the feature set is not nearly as complete as the Java viewer. In 3.1, the HTML feature set is much closer to that of the Java viewer.</li> <li>6) Improved administrative features (e.g., easier security management, improved remote system administration, improved diagnostic tools, etc.)</li> </ol>
6	<p>What's New – MARS Web Page</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The New in MARS section of the web page has been updated to reflect all major changes within the MARS system since January 2009. The page will continue to be updated monthly, following Council Meetings.</li> </ul>

7	<p><b>MARS Recertification</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Will be a more simple process this year and will kick off January 5<sup>th</sup>. In the past they had to have signatures for 3 forms (NDA, User Agreement and ROB) from several folks and fax them to the Help Desk. Now there is only 1 form (User Agreement and NDA together) and Rules of Behavior is understood as folks take their NOAA Security online class. Folks can simply update the form they receive and email it back to us – by them sending from their NOAA email account, that electronic signature will suffice, as CBS is now doing the same.
